

FERC Online, Register, Subscribe or Comment

To Register:

Go to FERC's website — www.ferc.gov

- In the drop down menu of the tab **Documents & Filing**,
- click on **e-Register**.
- Follow the directions and fill out the form.
- This will give you a FERC I.D. and password (you will need to do this even if you have an e-Filing account).
- FERC Online will then send you an email confirming your registration.
- Go to your email program's Inbox and open the message from FERC Online. Click on the link to validate your account.
- **Once you are a registered FERC Online User, log in to FERC Online by entering your registered email address/FERC I.D. and your password.**

To Subscribe (to receive information when items are submitted for a specific Docket Number)

Go to FERC's website — www.ferc.gov

- In the drop down menu of the tab **Documents & Filing**,
- choose **e-Subscription**.
- Follow the instructions to subscribe.
- Click on the Log-in button, and enter your registered email address or FERC ID and your password.
- On the next screen, select eSubscription.
- Enter the docket number you are interested in: Northeast Energy Direct Docket #PF14-22
- Click on the Search button and wait a moment for a response.
- When the information appears – for example: #PF14-22 Application for a Certificate . . .
- Click on the blue cross in the far right column under the heading labeled "Select"
- Wait for it to appear in "Selected Dockets"
- Click on the Subscribe button.
- **Once you do this, you'll be notified via email as correspondence gets filed by FERC in that docket number.**

To Access Documents:

Go to FERC's website — www.ferc.gov

- In the drop down menu of the tab **Documents & Filing**,
- go to **e-Library**.
- On the e-Library page, click on **General Search**.
- On the General Search page, scroll down to Docket Number, and type #PF14-22 in the box:
- This will bring up a list of everything that has been filed in relation to that Docket number.
- You can choose to view the information on line or download it to your computer.

To make a comment

Go to FERC's website — www.ferc.gov

- In the drop down menu of the tab **Documents & Filing**,
- choose **e-comment**. You do not need to Register with FERC to Comment.
- It's best if you type up your comment before, and just copy and paste it into the box where you are allowed to make comments (6000 characters).
- Click on the e-Comment button. It will lead to a page on the FERC website with your name and email filled in.
- In the field for "Enter Docket Number," type docket number (No Spaces) Northeast Energy Direct Docket #PF14-22
- Click on the Search button and wait a moment for a response.
- Click on the blue cross in the far right column under the heading labeled "Select"
- A box for entering the comment appears. It lets you enter up to 6000 characters. It's best if you type up your comment before, and just copy and paste it into this box.
- **Click on Send Comment. FERC will send you an email confirming receipt of your comment.**
